Discovery Program

Discovery is a six-week intensive program where students learn social emotional skills necessary to be successful both in and out of school. Students graduate from Discovery into the Eagle Program.

Eagle Program

Students participate in meaningful, integrated, project-based classes. Students in the Eagle Program agree to practice their Discovery skills daily and to maintain good attendance.

Kilchis Program

Students in the Kilchis Program take Odysseyware classes, practice their Discovery skills, and attend regularly. Students who are successful in the Kilchis Program may reapply to the Eagle Program.

Attendance

Students are allowed 3 absences (excused or unexcused) each term. Students with more than 3 absences in a term will finish their credits in the Kilchis Program. Students must sign out and have parent permission before leaving school.

Technology

Students may only use phones or electronic devices before school and during lunch. Parents may contact students through the main office. Students with their phones out will be asked to put them in the cell phone locker for the remainder of the day. District computers may only be used for schoolwork (no social media or YouTube).

Safety

Our school is a safe place for all students and we do not tolerate profanity, bullying, defiance, disrespect, theft, weapons, assault, fighting, property damage, or having or using tobacco/drugs/alcohol.

Professional Dress

Professional dress doesn't include pajamas, blankets, disrespectful messages or images of tobacco/alcohol/drugs/guns/violence..
